



# Thanks to a possible fare hike, subway and bus riders may be traveling lighter this year.

Soon you could be paying \$2 for a subway or bus ride. Or as much as \$23 for a weekly pass. Either way, that will cost you \$250 or more a year.

That's unfair because New York City accounts for 84 percent of all transit use in the state, but receives only 63 percent in state transit funds.
