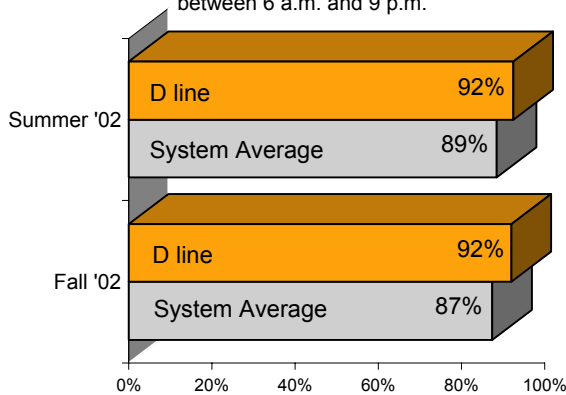
The D line is scheduled to come slightly less often than the average line. . .

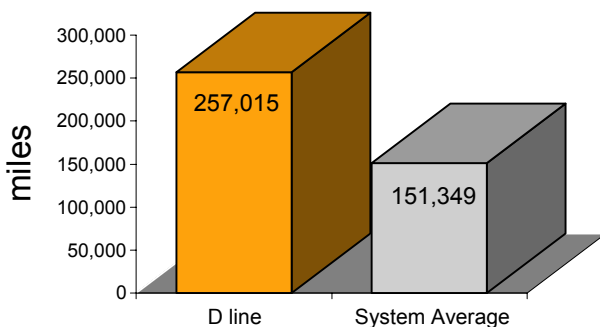
and arrives with tied-for-best regularity in the system.

between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.



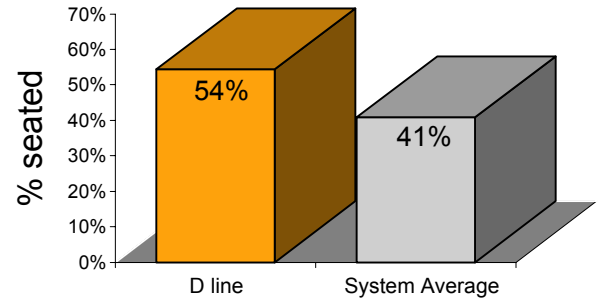
The D breaks down much less often than the average line.

mechanical failures, July to December 2002



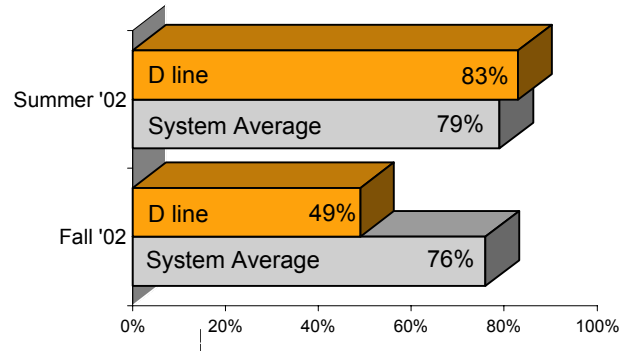
You're more likely to get a seat on the D than on any other line.

at most crowded point during rush hour



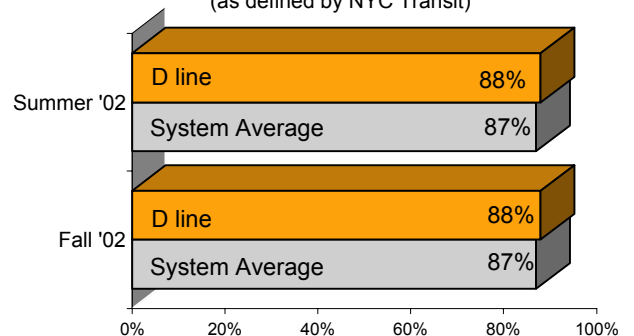
On cleanliness, the D is inconsistent. . .
