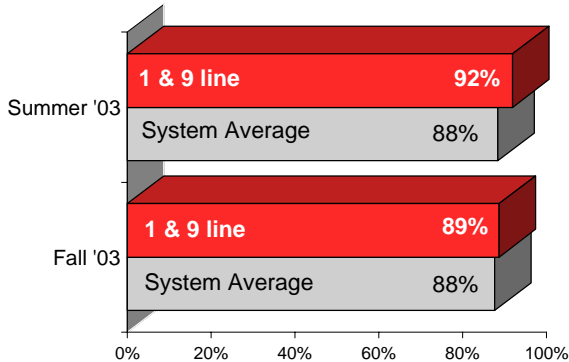
### The 1 & 9 line is scheduled to come more often than most subway lines. . .

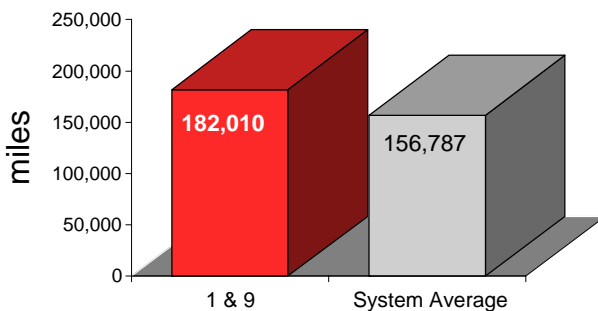
### and arrives with above-average regularity.

% of trains arriving at regular intervals (without gaps in service or train "bunching") between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.



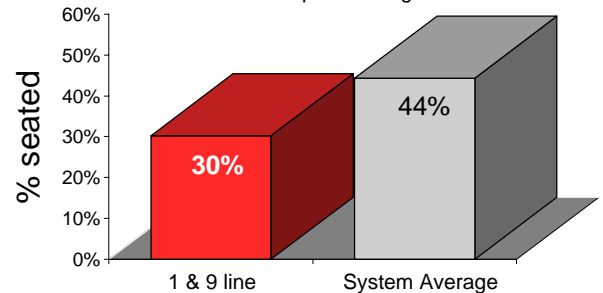
### Cars on the 1 & 9 break down less often than the average line.

average miles traveled between delays caused by mechanical failures, 2003



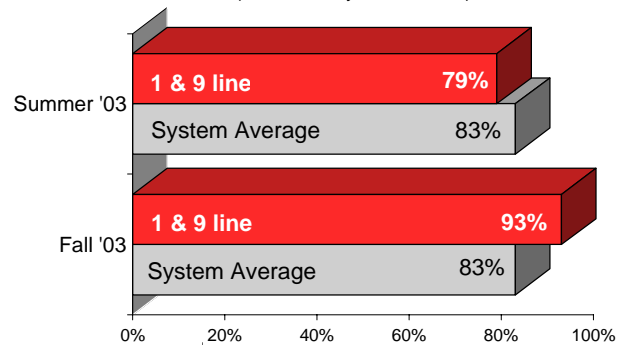
### You're less likely to get a seat on the 1 & 9.

% of passengers with seats at most crowded point during rush hour



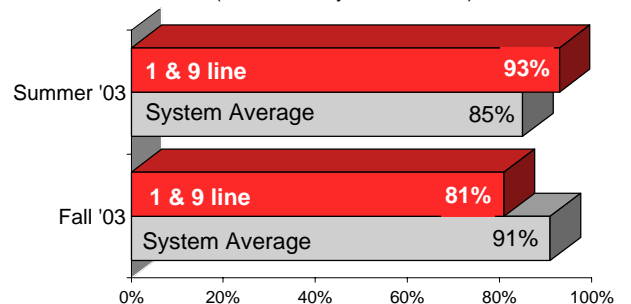
### On cleanliness, the 1 & 9 performs inconsistently. . .
