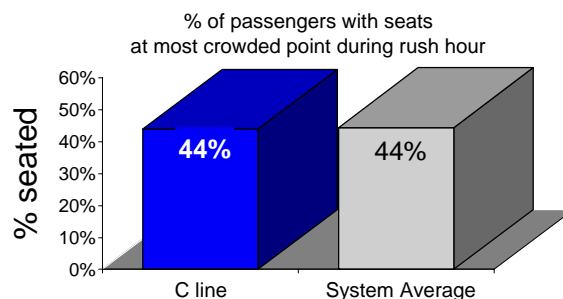

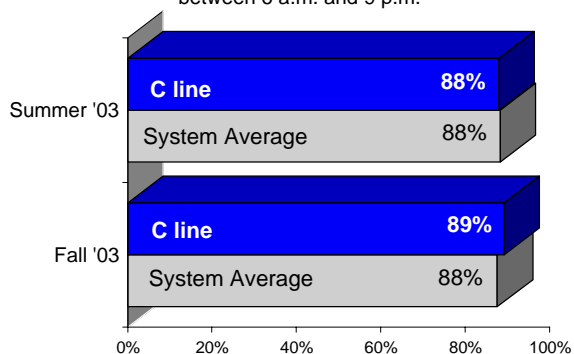

You have an average chance at getting a seat on the C.



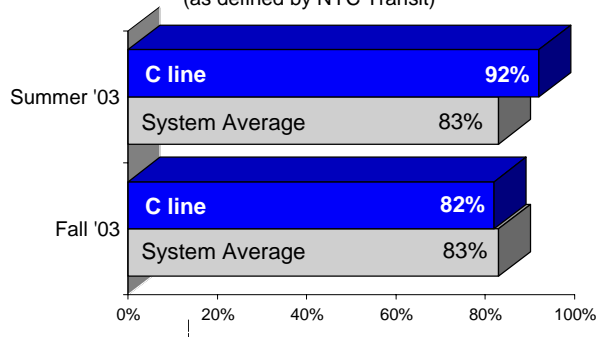
The C arrives with regularity at or above the system average. . .

between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.



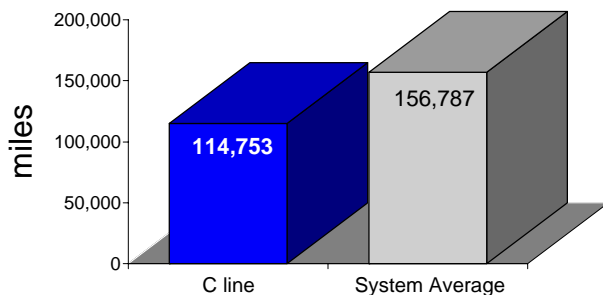
The C is cleaner than average. . .

(as defined by NYC Transit)



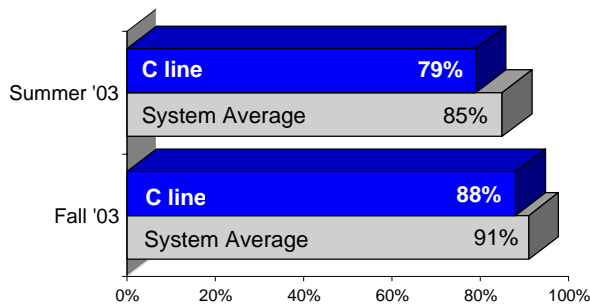
but its cars break down more often than the average line.
