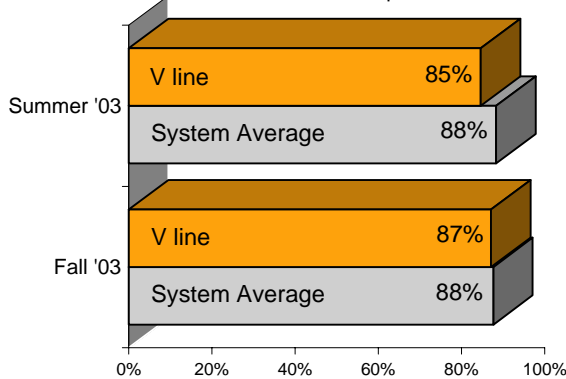
The V line has less than average daytime service and doesn't run at night. . .

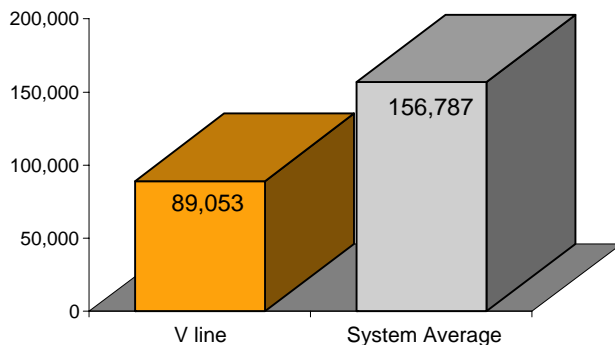
and arrives with below-average regularity.

between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.



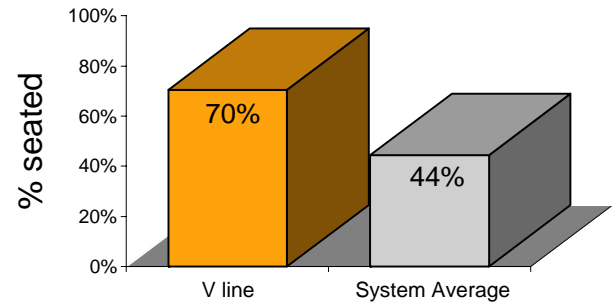
Cars on the V break down more often than those on the average line.

caused by mechanical failures, 2003



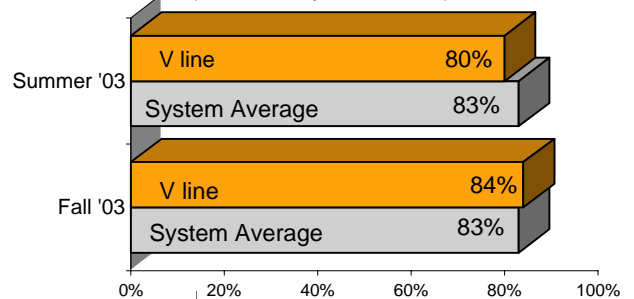
You're much more likely to get a seat on the V.

at most crowded point during rush hour



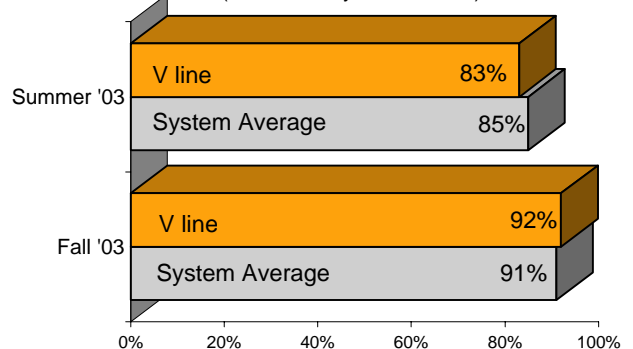
On cleanliness, the V line performs both above and below average. . .
