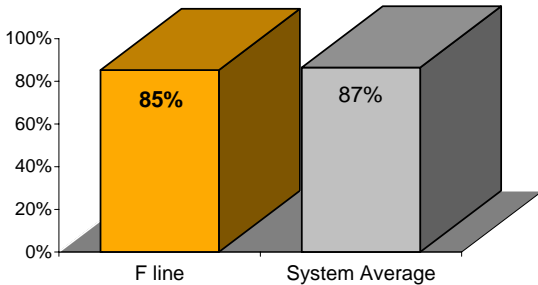
The F line has an above-average amount of scheduled service...

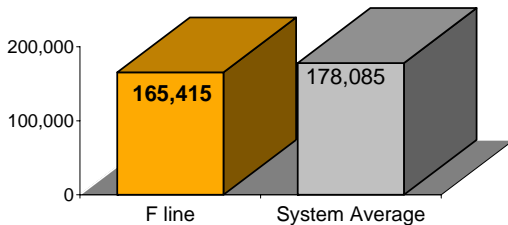
but arrives with below-average regularity.

between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.



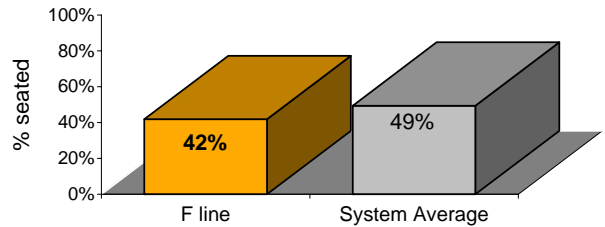
Cars on the F break down more often than those on the average line.

caused by mechanical failures, 2005



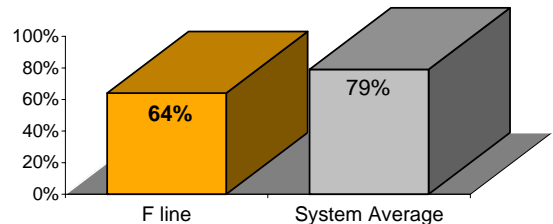
You're less likely to get a seat on the F line.

during rush hour



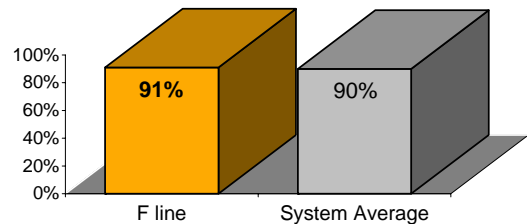
The F line is less clean than average...
